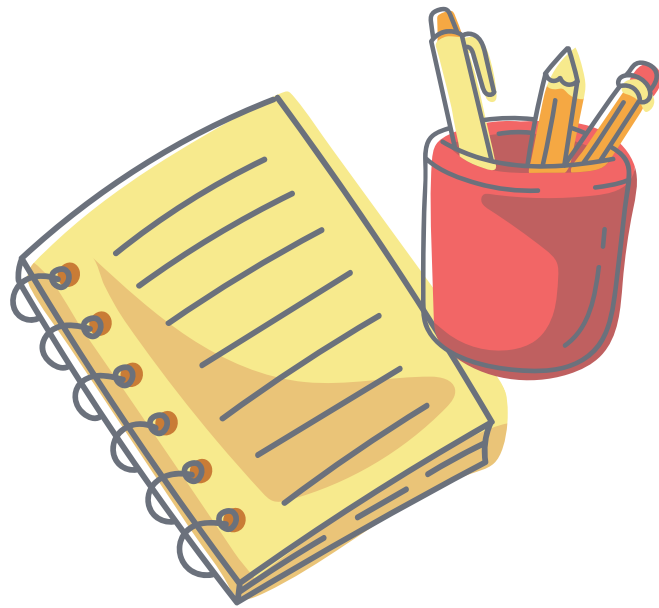

- Draw pictures of three community helpers (e.g., firefighter, teacher, doctor). Write a sentence about how they help us.
- Draw a picture of your favourite fruit and write a few sentences about why you like it.
- Make a list of five healthy foods and five unhealthy foods.
- Spend at least 30 minutes each day playing outside. Try different activities like running, skipping, or playing ball games.
- Practice five simple yoga poses. Hold each pose for 10 seconds and breathe deeply.

Subject: General Knowledge
