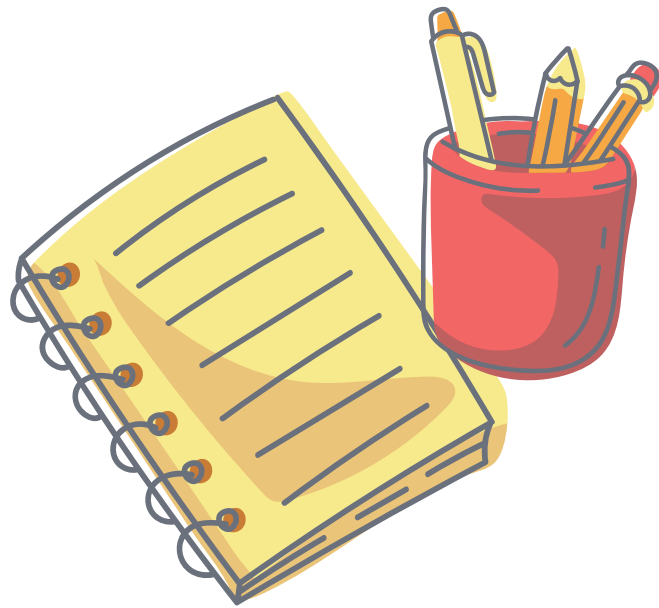

Subject: Environmental Studies

Assignment 1: Go for a nature walk with your family or friends. Take a notebook and pencil with you. Write a short description of each, including their colour, size, and any special features you notice.

Assignment 2: Collect materials that can be recycled such as old newspapers, cardboard, plastic bottles, etc. Use these materials to create a piece of art. It could be a sculpture, a collage, or any other creative idea you have in mind. Take a photo of your artwork and write a few sentences explaining how recycling helps the environment.

Assignment 3: Choose a plant seed such as a sunflower, tomato, or bean. Plant it in a small pot or in your garden. Take care of the plant by watering it regularly and providing it with sunlight. Keep a growth chart to track its progress. Take photos or draw pictures of the plant at different stages of growth.
