Dear Students,

Holidays are a break from studies, explanations and completing tasks. But are the holidays supposed to make you lazy? No, definitely not!!!! So, here are a few tasks planned to keep you occupied and help you in discovering the creative being in you.

Subject: English

Assignment 1: Your first task is to read at least two books of your choice during the holidays. You can choose any genre – adventure, mystery, fantasy, or even non-fiction. After reading each book, write a short summary highlighting the main characters, plot, and your favourite part of the story. Be creative and express your thoughts and feelings about the books you've read.

Assignment 2: Expand your vocabulary by learning five new words each day. Look up their meanings in the dictionary and try to use them in sentences of your own. Make a vocabulary journal where you can write down the new words, their meanings, and how you used them in sentences. Challenge yourself to incorporate these words into your everyday conversations.

Assignment 3: Watch an English-language movie or TV show with subtitles. Pay attention to the dialogue, pronunciation, and expressions used by the characters. After watching, write a brief review of the movie or show, highlighting your favourite parts and what you learned from it.

Subject: Hindi

Assignment 1: Write a paragraph (5-6 sentences) about your favourite holiday memory. Include details about where you went, what you did, and why it was special to you.

Assignment 2: किसी अपने दोस्त को या परिवार के सदस्य को एक पत्र लिखें। अपने अनुभव, यात्रा, या कोई खुशी के पल साझा करें।

Assignment 3: Draw a picture related to any Hindi proverb or saying. Write the proverb or saying below your drawing and explain its meaning in your own words.

Assignment 4: Write a short paragraph (about 50-60 words) on your favorite festival in Hindi. Include why you like it, how you celebrate it, and any special memories associated with it.

Subject: Mathematics

Multiplication and Division:

- Practice multiplication tables from 2 to 20. Write down the multiplication tables three times each.
- Solve the following multiplication problems:
 $24 \times 5 =$ $37 \times 4 =$ $56 \times 3 =$ $82 \times 6 =$
 $19 \times 7 =$ $45 \times 8 =$
- Calculate the product of 234 and 56.
- Divide 486 by 18.
- Divide 432 by 6.
- If there are 48 cookies and 6 friends want an equal share, how many cookies will each friend get?
- A farmer has 315 apples to distribute equally among 5 baskets. How many apples will be in each basket?
- Calculate: $648 \div 9$
- There are 240 candies, and they need to be divided equally among 8 children. How many candies will each child get?
- If 375 pencils are to be packed into boxes, and each box can hold 25 pencils, how many boxes will be needed?

Fractions:

- a) Add the following fractions: $\frac{3}{4} + \frac{2}{5}$.
- b) Subtract $\frac{1}{3}$ from $\frac{2}{3}$.

Geometry:

- a) Identify and draw the following shapes: square, rectangle, triangle, circle, and hexagon.
- b) Find the perimeter of a rectangle with length 10 cm and width 6 cm.
- c) Calculate the area of a square with a side length of 8 cm.

Measurement:

- a) Convert 3.5 meters to centimetres.
- b) If 1 kilogram of apples costs \$2.50, how much would 500 grams of apples cost?
- c) Measure the length of objects around your house using a ruler. Record your measurements in centimetres and meters.
- d) Estimate and measure the length of your bed, cupboard, and dining table.

Time:

- a) Practice telling time by drawing the hour and minute hands on the clock for the following times:
9:30 1:45 4:15 7:20 11:55
- b) If it is 3:15 PM now, what time will it be after 2 hours and 45 minutes?
- c) Calculate the difference between 8:30 AM and 12:45 PM.

Extra Word Problems:

- a) Sarah bought 5 packs of chocolates, and each pack contains 12 chocolates. How many chocolates did she buy in total?
- b) There are 24 students in a class. If each student gets 3 chocolates, how many chocolates are needed in total?
- c) What is the sum of the first 20 odd numbers?
- d) If you divide 987 by 13, what is the quotient and remainder?

Subject: Environmental Studies

Assignment 1: Start a small garden at home with your favourite plants or vegetables. Learn about the basic needs of plants, such as sunlight, water, and nutrients. Make a gardening journal to track your progress and record any challenges or successes you encounter along the way.

Assignment 2: Set up a bird feeder in your backyard or balcony and observe the birds that visit. Keep a journal of the different bird species you see, noting their colours, sizes, and behaviours. Research the birds you observe to learn more about their habitats and migration patterns.

Assignment 3: Study different types of pollution (air, water, soil, noise) and their causes and effects on the environment. Brainstorm ways to reduce pollution in your surroundings. Design a poster campaign or write a short story or poem to raise awareness about the importance of protecting our planet from pollution.
