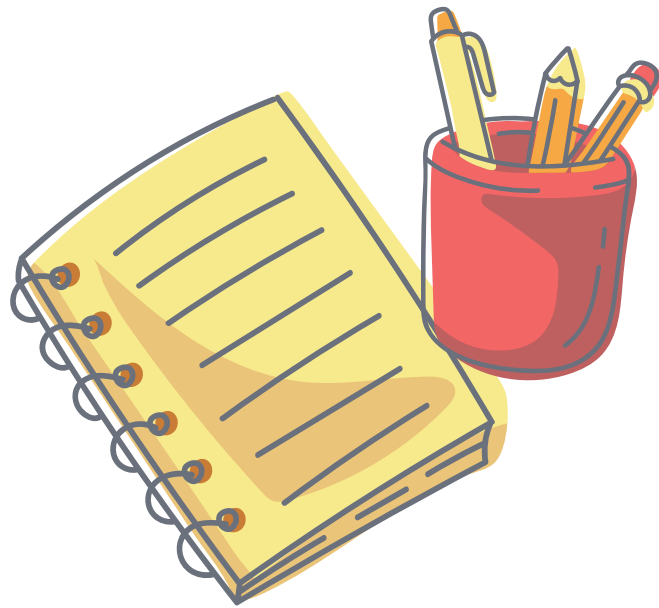

Holidays are a break from studies, explanations and completing tasks. But are the holidays supposed to make you lazy? No, definitely not!!!! So, here are a few tasks planned to keep you occupied and help you in discovering the creative being in you.

## Subject: English

### 1. Reading Assignment:

- Read a book of your choice from the following genres: adventure, mystery, fantasy, or historical fiction. After finishing the book, write a short book review. Include the following points in your review:
  - Title and author of the book
  - Summary of the plot
  - Your favourite character and why
  - What you liked/disliked about the book
  - Would you recommend it to a friend? Why or why not?

### 2. Writing Assignment:

- Write a creative story titled "The Magical Adventure." Your story should be at least 300 words long and must include the following elements:
  - A protagonist who discovers a magical object or place
  - The protagonist's journey through this magical world
  - Challenges or obstacles the protagonist faces
  - How the protagonist overcomes these challenges
  - A resolution or conclusion to the story

Feel free to let your imagination run wild and create an exciting and unique adventure!

- Draw the G20 Summit logo, and then write a brief paragraph about it, listing the countries and outlining the agenda.
- Design a new book cover for your favourite book, including a brief explanation of your design choices.

### 3. Vocabulary Building:

- Create a personal vocabulary journal.
- Every day, write down two new words you encounter while reading or in daily life.
- Include the word, its definition, and a sentence demonstrating its usage.
- At the end of the holidays, you should have a collection of at least 50 new words.

## Subject: Hindi

### 1. पठन समझ:

### 2. रचनात्मक लेखन:

### 4. अनुसंधान परियोजना:

- एक प्रसिद्ध हिंदी लेखक या कवि का चयन करें और उनके जीवन और हिंदी साहित्य में उनके योगदान का अध्ययन करें। उनके काम के महत्वपूर्ण पहलुओं को हाइलाइट करते हुए एक संक्षिप्त प्रस्तुति या पोस्टर तैयार करें।
- पाठ्य पुस्तक वसंत 2 के सभी पाठ एवं लेखकों के नाम लिखो व याद करो।
- किसी समाचार पत्र, पत्रिका या ऑनलाइन स्रोत से अपनी पसंद की कोई हिंदी कहानी या लेख पढ़ें। आपने जो पढ़ा है उसका एक संक्षिप्त सारांश लिखें, मुख्य बिंदुओं और मुख्य विवरणों पर प्रकाश डालें।

### 5. हिंदी क्विज:

- व्याकरण, और शब्दावली से संबंधित 40 प्रश्नों के साथ एक क्विज बनाएं।

## Subject: Mathematics

### Activity 1: Math Puzzles

Solve the following math puzzles:

- If a baker has 15 muffins and sells 8 of them, how many muffins does he have left?
- A rectangle has a length of 8 cm and a width of 5 cm. What is its perimeter?
- Find the missing number in the sequence: 5, 10, 15, ?, 25.
- If 3 apples cost ₹45, how much will 5 apples cost?
- A vendor supplies 32 litres of the milk to a hostel in the morning and 68 litres of milk in the evening. If the milk costs Rs 15 per litres, how much money is due to the vendor per day?
- Jai eats in a hotel which charges Rs 55 for lunch & Rs. 45 for dinner. Find the how much money he has to pay for seven days?
- In a bouquet there are 7 roses, 8 gladioli. In 9 bouquets, how many flowers are there?
- Shelly got 50 marks in Math, 39 marks in English & 51 in science. John got 62 marks in Math, 32 in English & 54 in Science. What are their total marks?
- The cost of T.V in Rs. 35,000. The dealers allows a discount of Rs. 7500 on Diwali. Find the selling price?
- Sarah has 24 chocolates. She wants to share them equally among her 4 friends. How many chocolates will each friend get?
- If a train travels at a speed of 60 kilometers per hour, how far will it travel in 3 hours?
- A box contains 56 pencils. If 8 pencils are taken out every day, how many days will it take to empty the box completely?

### Activity 2: Measurement Madness

Explore measurement in your environment:

- Measure the length and width of your bedroom in meters.
- Find three objects in your house and measure their weight in kilograms.
- Estimate the volume of water in your bathtub/bucket in litres.

### Activity 3: Create Your Own Math Problem

- Design a math problem for your classmates to solve. Be creative and make it challenging!

## Subject: Science

- Select a famous scientist and research their life, contributions to science, and significant discoveries. Create a biography or presentation to present your findings to the class.
- Create a science quiz consisting of multiple-choice questions, true/false statements, and short answer questions based on first 3 chapters of your science book. Include questions to test your classmates' understanding of different concepts. Provide answers along with explanations for each question.
- **Germination Experiment:** Plant seeds of different types (beans, peas, sunflower, etc.) in separate pots and observe the germination process. What conditions do seeds need to germinate?
- Research and create a poster on one environmental issue that concerns you. It could be pollution, deforestation, climate change, or any other topic related to the environment. Include information about the causes, effects, and possible solutions to the problem. Use colourful images and catchy slogans to make your poster impactful.

## Subject: Social Science

- Choose any two chapters from your Social Science textbook (History, Geography, Civics, or Economics) that you found most interesting. Read these chapters thoroughly and make concise notes summarizing the main points, key terms, and any questions you have.
- Country Profile: Choose a country of your interest (different from your own if possible) and create a comprehensive country profile. Include information such as:
  - a) Location and Geography
  - b) Capital City
  - c) Population
  - d) Official Language(s)
  - e) Currency
  - f) Famous Landmarks
  - g) Major Industries
  - h) Climate
  - i) Government
- Design a poster highlighting the importance of preserving historical monuments or natural landmarks. Include pictures, facts, and persuasive arguments to encourage others to protect these valuable assets for future generations.
- Find a recent news article related to any social, political, or economic issue in your country or around the world. Write a short summary of the article.
- Interview a family member (parent, grandparent, etc.) about their experiences growing up. Ask them about their childhood, school life, and any historical events they remember witnessing. Write a brief report summarizing the interview and highlighting any insights you gained.

### Submission Guidelines:

- All assignments should be self-created, colourful, and neatly handwritten.
- Relevant pictures can be pasted.
- Remember to check your work for spelling and grammar errors before turning it in.
- Ensure your name, class, section, and roll number are mentioned on each page and project.
- Kindly submit all subjects' holiday homework within 10 days (10<sup>th</sup> July) of the reopening of school.
